>>IMPORTANT <<**>>Online Threats<<**

Kittson County Sheriff Steve Porter and Chief Deputy Matt Vig will be conducting an informational presentation at the Lancaster Covenant Church. The title of the presentation will be Online Threats. Sheriff Porter and Chief Deputy Vig will discuss recent cases that have occurred in Kittson County, specifically cases that have targeted our youth, the elderly in our community, and our community in general. The discussion will include the very real threat that these cases pose, and the ideas and actions that can be used to keep people from becoming victims. The cases that are chosen for discussion will not be cases involving any local "real" victims. No victim names or identities will be released. This presentation is for adults only. We will be discussing adult information, which will not be appropriate for anyone under the age of eighteen. Our goal is to educate people about online threats and to prevent someone else from becoming a victim.
